What is NASCOE doing for YOU?

Here are some of the **NASCOE** negotiations

Issue- The change of the arc/plc deadline to March 15 has caused some issues. It was proposed to change the deadline to August 1.

Resolution— It can't be changed for this farm bill, but they will look at options for the next one.

Issue-COTs and new CEDs are being hired in at grades lower than the PTs. It was proposed that in at a grade 5, they will the policy be updated to ensure all CEDs hire in at promotion after 6 a grade 9.

Resolution– 27-PM has been updated to ensure that any grade 7 or 8 PT with minimum time in grade would be hired as a grade 9 CEDT. While there are still situations where a CED would hire be eligible for a months.
